Here's The Plan for Next Week:

Reading

Readers will read multiple texts centered around the theme of traveling. They will refer to specific stanzas in a poem to explain how the words appeal to their senses. They will ask and answers questions while reading to demonstrate their understanding of the text. Readers will use also determine the meaning of new words formed when the suffix -ly is added.

Writing

Students will continue to use their organized notes to draft their report on their Big Zoo Lesson animal.

Grammar and Spelling

Students will work on forming and using future tense verbs, and using commas and quotation marks in dialogue. Our spelling words will focus on -oo and uCe chunks.

Math Focus: Geometry

Mathematicians will finish a unit on geometry. We will focus the week on using strategy to solve problems. Chapter test will be on December 9th..

Social Studies Focus: Michigan

Explorers will finish chapter four in their *Meet Michigan* books. We will learn about economics, including vocabulary words such as entrepreneur, supply and demand. We will have an in-class open book test.
