Here are next week's objectives:

Reading

- I can follow agreed-upon rules for discussions: gaining the floor in respectful ways, listening to others with care, speaking one at a time about the topics and texts under discussion.
- I can determine the main ideas and supporting details of a text read aloud.
- I can recount stories from diverse cultures.
- I can determine the central message, and explain how it is conveyed through key details in the text.
- I can summarize the most important events in a story.
- I can distinguish my own point of view from that of the narrator or those of the characters.
- I can identify the character's point of view.
- I can explain how specific aspects of a text's illustrations contribute to what is conveyed by the words in a story.
- I can ask and answer questions to demonstrate understanding of a text, referring explicitly to the text as the basis for my answers.
- I can read on-level with accuracy, appropriate rate, and expression.

Writing/Language Arts

- I can write narratives to develop real or imagined experiences or events using descriptive details and clear event sequences.
- I can use dialogue and descriptions of actions, thoughts, and feelings to develop experiences and events or show the response of characters to situations.
- I can establish a situation and organize an event sequence that unfolds naturally.
- I can acquire and use accurately grade appropriate conversational, general academic, and domain-specific words and phrases.

- I can determine the meaning of words and phrases as they are used in a text, distinguishing literal from nonliteral language.
- I can clarify the meaning of unknown and multiple-meaning words, choosing from a range of strategies.
- I can use sentence-level context as a clue to the meaning of a word or phrase.
- I can use glossaries or beginning dictionaries, both print and digital, to determine or clarify the precise meaning of keywords and phrases in all content areas.
- I can use a known root word as a clue to the meaning of an unknown word.
- I can expand vocabulary by adding inflectional endings, prefixes, and suffixes.
- I can explain the function of pronouns.
- I can use pronouns correctly.
- I can identify subject and object pronouns.
- I can proofread sentences for mechanics and usage errors.
